Our Brumby's needed to be removed off the land belonging to the Hull family. We have been lucky to have had the use of this land for several years. Many thanks to Mrs C.Hull and family. We have now relocated them to land belonging to Mr. John Ross. Several weekends were spent "proofing" the fenceline. All have settled in and are doing well.

We now have our herd spread around the local district. Mrs F.Preuss, Mr J.Ross, Mr R Fraser, Mr K Schlink and Mr P McCracken all have society brumby's on their land. Mares and foals are at Brumby's Run. Our yearlings are roaming on land belonging to 'Vicky' in the Charlton Gully area. The new foaling season is well under-way. There is only one mare still to foal. Fifteen mares were used last season, and four stallions. All the foals are "peas in a pod". Even though they have different sires the Timor brumby features are well and truly their main character.

Several of the foals have been handled and show excellent temperament. All looks good for their future. Any-one wishing to get involved with these brumby's can do so . All that is required is that you become a financial member of the society and we will help you interact with these youngsters. The next handling day will be sometime in January 2012 when the harvest is finished.



This year we have mated eight mares. A new liver chestnut stallion "REDWINGS" is being used for the first time. The society has bred him.
